- Wesley Morgan, an author and journalist, has earned the William E. Colby Award 2022 for his military and intelligence writing. His book "The Hardest Place: The American Military Adrift in Afghanistan's Pech Valley" was cited.
- The Colby Award, named after former CIA Director William E. Colby, is granted for "a significant contribution to the knowledge of military history, intelligence operations, or international affairs."
- Norwich University in Northfield, Vermont, bestows the Colby Award.

On May 20th, the world observes World Bee Day

- The purpose of World Bee Day is to recognise the importance of bees and other pollinators in the environment.
- This year, the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) will commemorate World Bee Day with a virtual event themed 'Bee Engaged: Celebrating the Diversity of Bees and Beekeeping Systems.'
- World Bee Day was established on May 20, 2018, and has been observed annually since then. This day marks Anton Jansa's birth in 1734. She is regarded as a beekeeping expert.

- National Endangered Species Day is observed every year on the third Friday in May by people all across the world. The date for this year's celebration is May 20.
- National Endangered Species Day is observed with a focus on the preservation of our planet's flora and fauna. The day serves as a reminder to humans that they can do a lot to safeguard these species, with the goal of teaching people about conservation, ecosystem restoration, and biodiversity.

Rajnath Singh unveils the INS Surat and INS Udaygiri, two Indian-built warships

- The INS 'Surat' and 'Udaygiri,' both manufactured in India, were inaugurated at the Mazagon Docks in Mumbai by Defence Minister Rajnath Singh.
- The Directorate of Naval Design (DND) developed both warships in-house and constructed them at MDL in Mumbai.
- The fourth destroyer in Project 15B, the Indian Naval Ship (INS) Surat, is named after Western India's second-largest economic hub.
- The third ship of the Project 17A Frigates is the Indian Naval Ship (INS) Udaygiri, named after a mountain range in Andhra Pradesh. It is a successor to the Shivalik Class P17 Frigates, with increased stealth, sophisticated weaponry and sensors, and platform management systems.
